Digging Deeper:

1. What does the author of Hebrews mean when he says Christ has opened "a new and living way through the curtain"? How do we enter the presence of God now? Explain the role Christ's priestly work and sacrifice play in this new and living way.

2. Why are we able to draw near to the Father with a sincere heart and full assurance? How does Scripture affirm that Christians can have full assurance in their salvation? Give examples.

3. Why does a Christian need the church? What does the church offer to an individual believer that she cannot get elsewhere or on her own? How does the local church help us endure in the faith and hold on to our confession?
